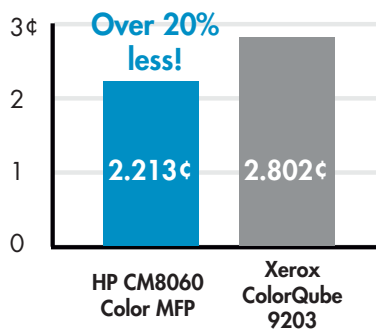

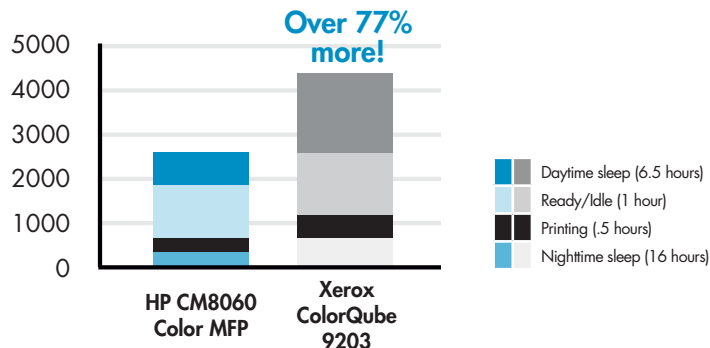

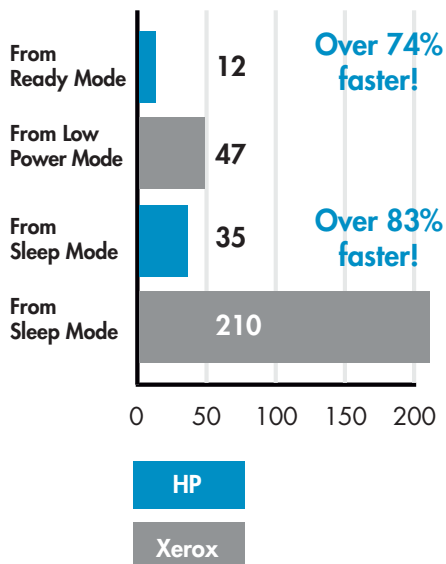
#### Ink Cost Per Page

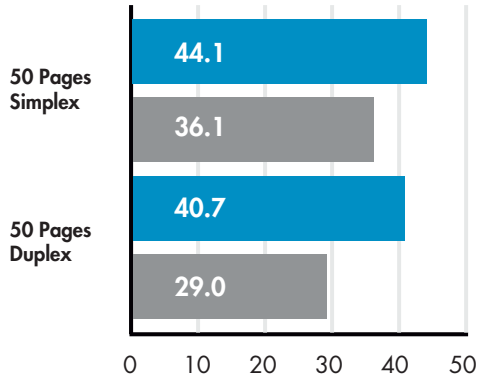

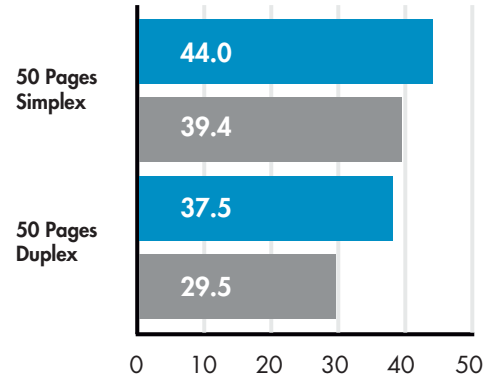

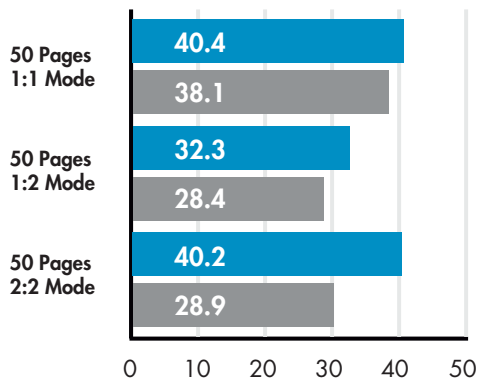
### Auto-Color Print Speed in PPM



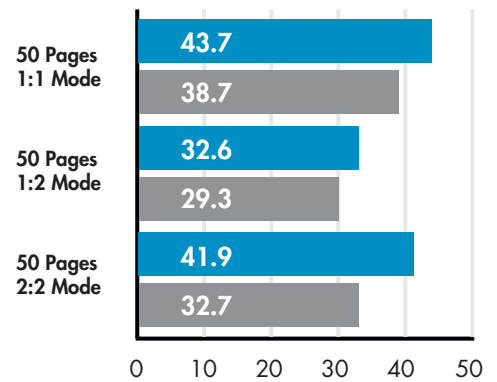
### Black Print Speed in PPM
