# 3-D penguin

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Time to Complete: Approximately 40 minutes

Level: Medium

### GETTING STARTED

**Materials:**

- Metal-edged ruler
- Butter knife
- Scissors or X-ACTO knife
- Cutting mat (optional)
- Multipurpose glue
- Pencil

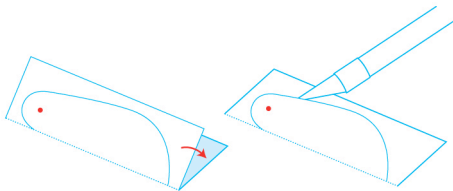
1. Score all the pieces: Using a ruler as a guide, run the back side of a butter knife firmly along all the dotted lines.



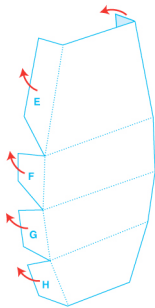
2. Using scissors or an X-ACTO knife and cutting mat, cut out all pieces along the solid lines, being sure to only cut out boxes around wings and feet. Also, be sure to make cut on mouth piece.



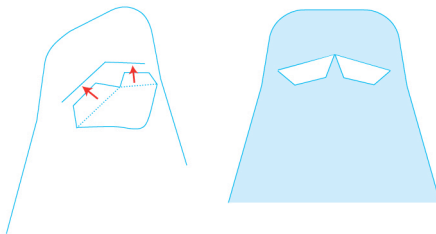
### ASSEMBLE YOUR PENGUIN



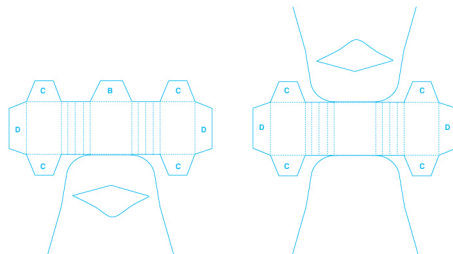
3. Fold each wing and foot piece down the center dotted line and glue together. Once dry, cut out each piece along solid lines.



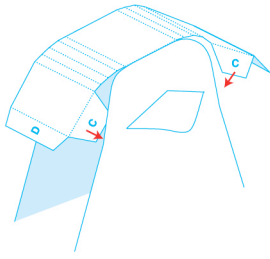
4. On both body pieces, fold all tabs back on dotted lines.



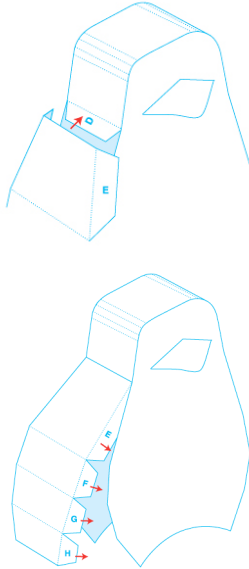
5. Insert tabs of beak piece into mouth slit, and glue in place.



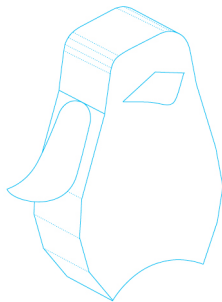
6. Glue tab A on head piece inside the top of front piece. Then, glue tab B on head piece inside top of back piece. Allow to dry completely.



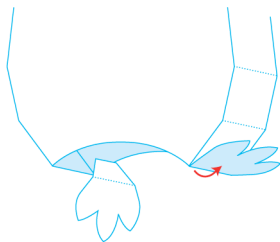
7. Glue all C tabs on head piece to the insides of front and back pieces.



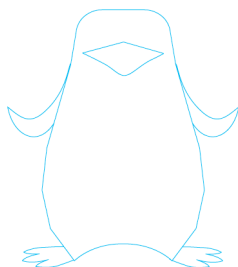
8. Glue top of one side body piece to tab D on head piece and allow to dry. Repeat with other side. Then, glue tabs E through H to front and back pieces.



9. Slightly curl the wings using a pen or pencil. Place a dab of glue where wings are marked with a dot, and glue to sides of body, so flat edges face forward.



10. Glue tab on foot to inside of lower side body, with lighter orange side facing up. Fold foot upward. Repeat with other foot.



11. You're done!
