## Stephen Nigro

Senior Vice President and General Manager of the Graphics and Imaging Business

Stephen Nigro is the senior vice president and general manager of the Graphics and Imaging Business (GIB) in the Imaging and Printing Group (IPG) at HP. Nigro's organization is responsible for IPG's graphics businesses, generating new imaging system businesses and for developing new printing and non-printing technologies.

GIB leads the strategy to capture high-value pages by developing compelling solutions for the industrial, commercial printing and graphics segments. This includes responsibility for large format (DesignJet) printers, Indigo digital presses, digital publishing solutions, graphics printing solutions, and specialty printing systems. The imaging system businesses consist of digital projection systems and the new "Halo" virtual conferencing systems.

GIB also includes some of HP's most valuable technology development assets. GIB is responsible for developing HP's own printing technologies, including all inkjet systems, liquid electrophotography and LightScribe. These technology development capabilities also contribute to developing new technologies to enable the imaging systems business.

Nigro joined HP in 1981, working as a summer hire in San Diego. Before coming to HP's Corvallis, Ore., site in 1990, he worked for the company in San Diego from 1982-1990. Nigro worked in Singapore from 1991-1994 after which he returned to Corvallis, where he continues work.

Nigro holds a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of California at Santa Barbara and a master's degree in electrical engineering from Stanford University. He is a member of the advisory board for Oregon State University Engineering School's Top 25 program and also serves on the Oregon Business Council's board.
