



## Brian Levy

Brian Levy is vice president and chief technology officer for the Communications, Media and Entertainment business unit at HP.

Most recently, Levy was group technology officer for Service Strategy and Innovation at BT. He was instrumental in BT's 21st Century Network program, for which he developed the service-oriented architecture for the network and initiated the development of many new transformational services.

Prior to BT, Levy held various roles in operations, marketing and product development at Qwest, GTS and Storm Telecommunications, where he led the marketing, definition, design and deployment of one of the first pan-European Ethernet connectivity services. He also was a co-founder and senior vice president for Architecture and Operations for the startup company Aduronet.

For nine years, Levy worked at AT&T in Europe, the Middle East and Africa (EMEA), where he led the rollout of the "Interspan" frame relay service, part of the largest network of its type in the world. He also led the development of all new services in EMEA for AT&T, was director of Network Services in EMEA, and led the definition and deployment of AT&T's IP and hosting services. Additionally, he led the production of AT&T's European IP services business plans and the service integration between AT&T and its joint venture at the time, AUCS.

Levy's career also includes nine years with BBC in radio and TV broadcasting. He began his career with BT in 1970 with an apprenticeship as an engineer. He received an award from BT to attend Salford University, U.K., where he obtained an honors degree in electronic communication.
