This includes responsibility for Designjet large-format printers, Indigo digital presses, digital publishing solutions, graphics printing solutions and specialty printing systems. The imaging system businesses consist of digital projection systems and the HP Halo Collaboration Studio.

The Graphic and Imaging Business also includes some of HP's most valuable technology development assets, such as HP's proprietary printing technologies, including all inkjet systems and liquid electrophotography, as well as the LightScribe Direct Disc Labeling technology. These technology development capabilities also contribute to developing new technologies to enable the imaging systems business.

Based in Corvallis, Ore., Nigro holds a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of California at Santa Barbara and a master's degree in electrical engineering from Stanford University. He is a member of the advisory board for Oregon State University Engineering School's Top 25 program and also serves on the Oregon Business Council's board.
