Olivier Helleboid is vice president of Adaptive Infrastructure in the Technology Solutions Group at HP. Helleboid rejoined HP in 2005 and served as vice president of HP Software, where he led the successful integration of the Peregrine acquisition and achieved increased profitability for the business unit.

Previously, Helleboid spent more than two years at BEA Systems as executive vice president of Products, Corporate Development and Strategy. He also held the position of chief executive officer of Rainfinity, a security and storage virtualization start-up company that serviced more than 300 enterprise customers and several original equipment manufacturer partnerships.

During his first stint at HP during the mid-90s, Helleboid was vice president and general manager for its OpenView business unit. Under his leadership, HP OpenView gained the No. 1 position in distributed management solutions and established itself as the industry leader in IT service management.

Helleboid is a 20-year veteran of the networking and server industry. He received an engineer's degree from the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Telecommunications in Paris, France, and also holds a master's degree in management from the Sloan School of Management at MIT.
