

Spohn serves on the boards of the Idaho Science, Mathematics and Technology Coalition and the Treasure Valley Mathematics & Science Center. In December, 2006, she was appointed to the Governor's Science and Technology Advisory Council for the state of Idaho. She was honored by the Women in Technology International Hall of Fame in 2006 as one of the world's "five most pioneering women."
