Christine Martino is vice president and general manager of the Scalable Computing and Infrastructure organization at HP, responsible for the company's scale-out computing business targeting high-growth markets such as Web 2.0, cloud and high-performance computing.

Previously, Martino was vice president of the Open Source & Linux Organization at HP, where she had responsibility for research and development, strategic and product marketing, business planning, worldwide alignment with customers and partners across the regions, and open source community participation and support.

In this role, she led numerous groundbreaking initiatives, which furthered HP's position in the Linux and open source space and solidified the company as a valued member of the open source community. During her tenure, HP extended its market lead by 7 percentage points in worldwide Linux server units and 10 percentage points in worldwide Linux server revenue.

Martino also led the Telco Carrier Grade server business from start-up to a profitable multi-million dollar operation as this customer base transitioned from highly custom solutions to off-the-shelf standard products. She also ran worldwide marketing for the HP 3000, helped migrate and retain the loyal customer base, and held strategic and technical marketing management roles in the company's Video Communications Division, where HP went from virtual unknown to No. 2 in the broadcast server marketplace.
