Gary Cutler is vice president and general manager of the Edgeline Technologies Business Unit at HP. He is responsible for research and development, as well as business and manufacturing strategy for Edgeline Technology.

Edgeline imaging systems and components are integrated into HP business imaging products, industrial printing applications and solutions for the photographic industry.

Cutler began his career with HP in 1981 as a research and development engineer in Corvallis, Ore., making contributions to several HP products, including compilers, operating systems and calculators. In 1984, he began working on scanning and printing products. He was promoted to R&D project manager for systems drivers in 1986 and assumed responsibility for driver development for both Windows and Macintosh printer applications in 1989.

Cutler was named Software Lab manager and division R&D manager in 1993 and 1995, respectively. He became division manager in 1997 and was named an HP vice president in 2000.

A native of upstate New York, Cutler received his undergraduate degree from the University of New York and his master's degree in mathematics and physics from the University of Vermont. He also did post-graduate work in mathematics at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York. Prior to joining HP, Cutler taught college-level courses at the University of Vermont.
