Irv Rothman is chief executive officer and president of HP Financial Services, a wholly owned subsidiary of HP. He is responsible for the worldwide delivery of customized leasing, financing and financial asset management solutions that simplify customers' IT lifecycle management and reduce their total cost of ownership.

HP Financial Services supports all customer needs – from the largest corporate accounts to small and mid-sized businesses. The company is headquartered in Murray Hill, N.J., with regional headquarters in Dublin, Ireland, and Sydney, Australia. HP Financial Services has 1,100 employees worldwide and does business in more than 40 countries. It is the second-largest captive IT leasing company in the world.

Prior to joining HP, Rothman was chief executive officer and president of Compaq Financial Services Corporation, which he led from its founding in 1997, ultimately growing the business to greater than \$3.7 billion in total assets prior to Compaq's merger with HP.

During his more than 30 years in the leasing industry, Rothman has held leadership positions with U.S. Leasing International, Thomson McKinnon Securities and AT&T. As a group president of AT&T Capital Corporation, he helped build an organization that ultimately grew to be the second largest leasing company in the country.

Rothman attended Rutgers University and earned an MBA in finance from Pepperdine University. He serves on the board of the U.S. Soccer Foundation.
