Kupor joined Opware shortly after the company's founding and held numerous executive management positions, including vice president, financial planning and vice president, corporate development. In these roles, he led the company's private financing activities as well as its initial public offering in 2001; he started the company's Asia Pacific operations via strategic partnerships with NEC, NTT and Samsung; and he led the execution of the company's acquisitions of Tangram, Rendition, Creekpath and iConclude.

Prior to Opware, Kupor represented software companies in both financing and mergers and acquisitions transactions at Credit Suisse First Boston and Lehman Brothers. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from Stanford University with a bachelor's degree in public policy with honors and distinction.
