The HP Officejet 7000 Wide Format Printer is HP's first entry-level wide-format printer with individual inks. It delivers professional color documents and stunning photo-quality prints at the lowest cost per page versus in-class inkjets.⁽¹⁾ With the ability to create eye-catching borderless prints up to 13 x 19 inches, this versatile printer is ideal for micro and small businesses that need to create everyday business documents and marketing collateral in variety of sizes – from postcards to poster-size prints.
