The HP LaserJet Enterprise M806 will be available worldwide on October 1, 2013 and pricing options range between \$3,399 and \$5,399. The HP Color LaserJet Enterprise M855 will be available worldwide on November 1, 2013 and pricing options range between \$3,699 and \$5,699.
