Aurelio Maruggi is vice president and general manager of the Printing and Personal Systems Group's (PPS) Inkjet High-Speed Production Solutions Division (IHPS). Maruggi and his team are responsible for HP's industry-leading portfolio of high-speed inkjet web presses and related media, workflow and finishing solutions, which are accelerating the analog-to-digital print transformation in publishing, direct mail and commercial printing.

Under Maruggi's leadership HP IHPS developed a broad portfolio of high-speed inkjet web presses, composed of three platforms and eight products as of 2011, in record time.

Maruggi joined HP in December 2002 to manage HP IPG Strategic Alliances. In 2005, his managerial role at HP was expanded to include Original Equipment Manufacturer Business Development, Operations and Sales of HP products and inkjet technology.

Prior to HP, Maruggi was vice president of the Inkjet Products Division at Olivetti. He also served as general manager of Jotech, a joint venture between Olivetti Lexikon and Philips, in which he was chartered to develop fax and internet appliances for the European market.

Maruggi co-founded Yminds S.A. in Switzerland, an engineering firm specializing in advanced micromechanics and color science, and he has served as director of the boards of Olivetti I-Jet S.p.A., Jotech S.p.A. and Yminds S.A.

Maruggi holds a master's degree in electrical engineering from the University of Padua in Italy.
