Stephen Bovis is the vice president and general manager of HP Servers for Asia Pacific and Japan.

Bovis and his organization focus on extending HP's long term leadership in the server market. In this role, he is responsible for business management, sales and strategy for the industry's broadest server portfolio including HP Moonshot; HP ProLiant, the world's number one server brand; HP BladeSystem, the world's number one bladed infrastructure; and mission-critical computing with the HP Integrity and Nonstop platforms.
