Irv Rothman leads HP Financial Services, a wholly owned subsidiary of HP. In this role, Rothman is responsible for the worldwide delivery of customized leasing, financing and financial asset management solutions that simplify customers' IT life cycle management and reduce their total cost of ownership. HP Financial Services supports all customer needs, from the largest corporate accounts to small and mid-sized businesses.

The company is headquartered in Berkeley Heights, N.J., with regional headquarters in Dublin, Ireland, and Sydney, Australia. HP Financial Services has 1,100 employees worldwide and does business in more than 40 countries. It is the second-largest captive IT leasing company in the world.

Prior to joining HP, Rothman was president and chief executive officer of Compaq Financial Services Corporation (CFS). He led CFS from its founding in 1997, growing the business to greater than \$3.7 billion in total assets prior to the HP-Compaq merger.

With more than 30 years in the leasing industry, Rothman held leadership positions with U.S. Leasing International and Thomson McKinnon Securities before joining AT&T in 1985. As a group president of AT&T Capital Corporation, he helped build an organization that ultimately grew to be the second largest leasing company in the country.

Rothman attended Rutgers University and earned an MBA in Finance from Pepperdine University. He serves on the board of the U.S. Soccer Foundation.
