Stephen Nigro is senior vice president of the Imaging and Printing businesses within HP's Printing and Personal Systems (PPS) group.

HP's Imaging and Printing business consists of consumer and small and midsize business (SMB)-focused inkjet printing solutions that deliver new business model innovations with market-leading solutions centered on mobility and the cloud.

The Graphics Solution Business addresses print service provider (PSP) customer needs by providing the highest-quality inkjet and LEP solutions on the market. The Graphics mission is to transform pages across the graphics industry from analog to digital.

Nigro joined HP in 1981 in San Diego as a research and development (R&D) engineer and his experience over the years has been both extensive and critical to the success of HP's printer business. One of the early inkjet pioneers, he concentrated on large-format devices and the development of the first color inkjet device. Nigro set up the first HP inkjet manufacturing operation outside the United States and has had a hand in all areas of inkjet technology including print heads, writing systems, inks and R&D for consumer, office and graphics. He was also responsible for the creation of the HP Graphics business.

Nigro holds a Bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of California at Santa Barbara and a Master's degree in electrical engineering from Stanford University.
