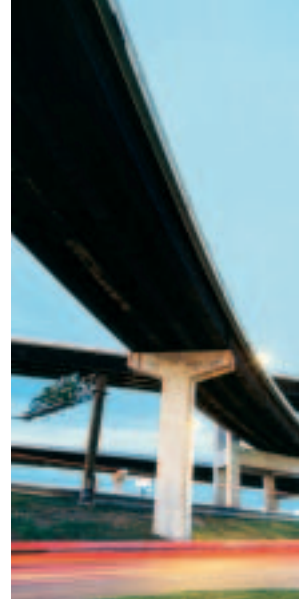


Migrating from the HP e3000 platform
