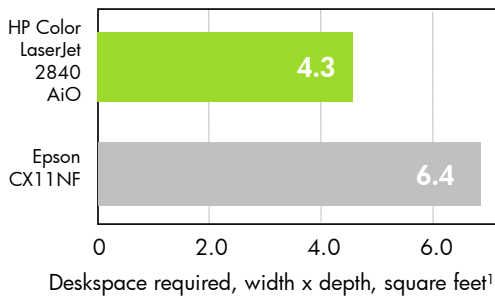


# HP Color LaserJet 2840 All-in-One vs. Epson CX11NF



**Significant differences between these devices could impact...**

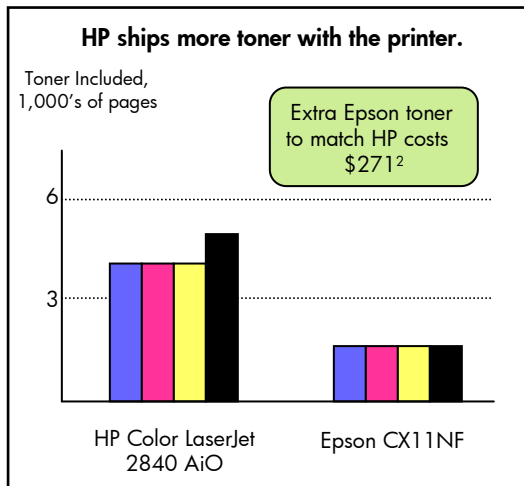
## Less desk space required with HP.



## productivity:

**Less desk space required** – The HP Color LaserJet 2840 AiO requires about 50% less desk space compared to the Epson CX11NF, when you open all the doors and extend the Epson lens cleaning wand. HP requires 4.3 square feet based on width x depth of 19.5" x 31.5", compared to 6.4 square feet for Epson based on 28.4" x 32.5". Also, HP requires less vertical space – only 31.5" compared to Epson's 35".<sup>1</sup>

**Fast warm-up time** – From Powersave mode, the HP Color LaserJet 2840 AiO prints the first page in 29 seconds, compared to Epson's 39 seconds.<sup>1</sup> This performance advantage is due to HP's Instant-On Technology which eliminates delays for fuser warm-up from Powersave mode.



## Reliability and cost:

**More toner in the box** – The HP Color LaserJet 2840 AiO ships with more Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Black toner than the Epson CX11NF. HP ships toner for 4,000 CMY pages and 5,000 black pages, while Epson includes toner for only 1,500 CMYK pages – the difference is a value of \$271 based on the cost of Epson toner cartridges.<sup>2</sup>

**Reliable imaging and printing** – The Epson CX11NF has a lens that needs to be cleaned periodically to avoid degradation of output quality that could impact both printing and copying. This type of cleaning procedure is not required with the HP Color LaserJet 2840 AiO. Also, when printing, HP supports PCL 6 and PostScript 3 emulation which ensures compatibility and efficient use of network resources. The Epson CX11NF supports solely host-based printing and does not support PCL nor PostScript.
