Face Recognition for HP ProtectTools

Face recognition technology allows you to quickly log in to your notebook, web sites, and more using the webcam and security software from HP. The Setup Wizard for HP ProtectTools takes sample pictures of your face and configures the technology. You can then log in to your laptop and web sites using Face Recognition for HP ProtectTools.

The software automatically detects if your appearance changes, for example low light levels or the addition of glasses. If this occurs, it will simply ask you to re enroll so that it can build a comprehensive portfolio of your face. And if the lighting is too dark, the software will brighten your screen, turning it to all white, in order to light your face for the picture!

When you go to a web site or log on to your system, the option to log in using Face Recognition displays. Simply look at your screen, and your face becomes your password. If you want to increase security with additional authentication options, you can combine face recognition with other features such as fingerprint readers or smartcards.

HP QuickWeb

HP QuickWeb lets you access the web in seconds, even if your notebook is turned off. It resides outside of the notebook's operating system, so you don't have to wait for your system to boot. After configuration, simply pressing the dedicated QuickWeb button on your HP Notebook PC connects it to the Internet, providing access to web sites and any other content you can access through a web browser.

HP QuickWeb supports a variety of connection types—including Wi-Fi, LAN, and mobile broadband—which you can select when you first launch the feature. If needed, you can configure multiple types and easily connect using different networks.

To protect your business and personal information, QuickWeb includes security settings. Two security modes provide different levels of protection. The normal mode enables some restrictions, but lets you change settings, create bookmarks, and save files. The write-protected option prevents any content from being written or saved. QuickWeb also includes the option to restore the software to a previous state or to remove all user data, such as cookies and bookmarks. Note that HP QuickWeb is separate from the Windows operating system environment, and it does not affect the Windows environment in any way.

On the HP Advanced Docking Station, the eSATA port offers throughput rates of up to 3Gbps for convenient backup and storage. (Many HP Business Notebooks also include built-in eSATA ports). The HP 120W Advanced Docking Station also expands your notebook's functionality with an integrated Upgrade

Bay so you can add an optical drive, such as a DVD +/- RW drive, or a hard drive for additional storage or backing up data.

Both docking stations feature the proprietary HP Docking Station Cable Lock, in addition to an industry standard notebook lock slot. This new locking solution is simple to use and delivers enhanced security. Just dock the notebook, insert the key, and turn to secure your notebook, docking station, and select accessories with one key.

HP also offers the HP USB 2.0 Docking Station to connect a keyboard, mouse, monitor, printer, and other accessories for a desktop experience.
