



Dear Valued Customer:

In order to assist you with your future system planning, Hewlett-Packard would like to share with you the following support changes for Red Hat Directory Server for HP-UX. This is to ensure that you have the most up to date products to run your business.

The Red Hat Directory Server for HP-UX (RHDS) version 7.10.xx will no longer be supported after June 30, 2010. Customers using this version should plan to migrate to one of the following prior to this date:

1) HP-UX Directory Server version 8.1 or later.

The HP-UX Directory Server (HPDS) was released in September 2009. HPDS 8.1 is a follow-on to the Netscape and Red Hat directory server product line. HPDS is an HP branded directory server based on the same established and proven product source as the Red Hat directory server. This offering is the recommended directory server for HP-UX customers going forward. It contains the same functionality and should appear familiar to users of the Netscape and Red Hat directory server product line. Migration is a straightforward process from RHDS versions 7.1 and 8.0 and NDS versions 6.11 and 6.21. HPDS has no intranet or extranet licensing charges.
