## HP Photo Fun: Zoo Safari

On this safari, you'll need your trusty digital camera, your alert eyes, and your imagination to bag some amazing photos at the zoo. Ready? Let's go!

### Think small

Focus in on the little details that make animals so unique—and you'll come away with distinctive photos. Use the zoom lens or your camera's Macro mode to get these shots:

- A crocodile's eye, skimming through the water
- An elephant's foot—notice the curved toenails
- Spots and stripes—close in on the pelt of a leopard or zebra

### Think fast

Look for moments when animals are playing or eating. Be ready to click—animals move quickly. Use your camera's Action mode to get these shots:

- Penguins hopping into a pool
- A seal swimming up for its fish dinner
- A mother monkey grooming her baby

### Think people

People are some of the funniest animals at the zoo. Use your camera's Portrait mode to get these shots:

- A child's reaction to a lion's mighty roar
- Mom or Dad driving to the zoo, and back home—do they look different?
- Feeding time—for the humans! What are they eating? How does it taste?
