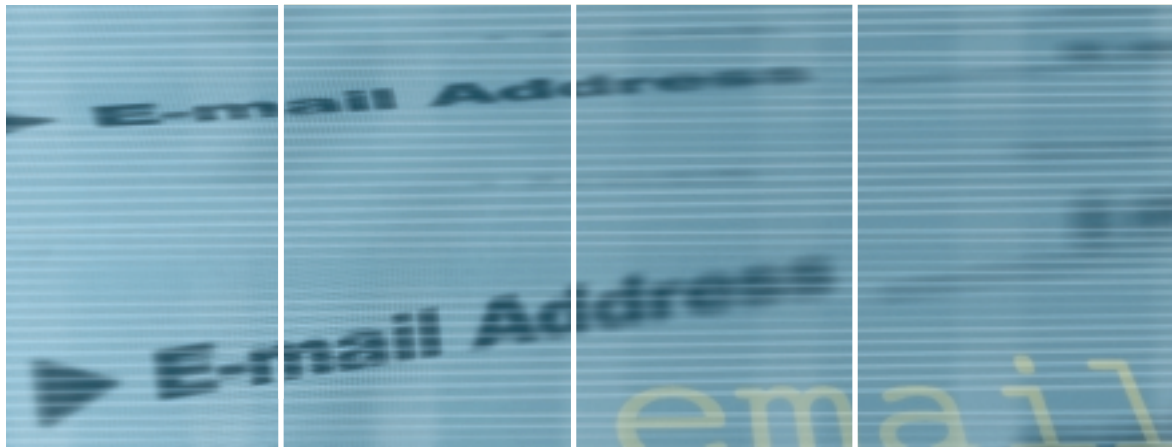

## Features

- *Trained Anti-Spam Engine* – the Filter goes well beyond traditional static keyword or block lists by creating a lexicon – or dictionary – of common Spam characteristics. The anti-Spam engine is trained with tens of thousands of messages to identify and inventory what is Spam and what isn't, increasing accuracy and reducing false positives.
- *Complete Email Inspection* – the Filter analyzes the entire message, including the headers, subject line, body text and over 200 attachment formats, including spreadsheets, word processing documents, graphics and PDFs.
- *Policy Enforcement* – rule sets and full-text analysis allow businesses to take a policy-based approach to message disposition. Append watermarks and legal disclaimers as needed, copy and archive outgoing messages to create an accurate corporate memory and ensure corporate and regulatory email compliance.
- *Choice of Actions for Suspect Messages* – the Filter can take specific, real-time actions on suspected Spam, including bounce, notification, redirection, deletion or appending the message. Rules can be set by user or group to facilitate department-level policy enforcement.

- *Scanning Sensitivity* – administrators determine the level of sensitivity for message scanning rules. Sensitivity can scale up or down to comply with company mandates.
- *Real-time Alerts* – provides immediate notification of policy violations based on rule sets.

- *Reduce Network Congestion* – large email attachments and Spam can cause congestion, leading to network slowdown and slow message throughput. The Sendmail Advanced Anti-Spam Filter helps dispose of unwanted or unneeded messages before they clog the network

- *Protect Confidential Data* – guard sensitive company information by filtering messages based on unauthorized content
